Students must hold a B2 language certificate (english or spanish) if he/she wants to take classes in a language different than his/her mother tongue. Please note that it is not sufficient to indicate that he/she has an optimal level of english; it is necessary to include the level in detail.

# Living Expenses

# Migratory Regulations

Apply here

- 1. Before travelling please verify any visa requirements. If the student does not need a visa, they will receive a PID letter from us. h
- 2. Upon arrival, the PID letter must be presented to the immigration officer (at the airport).
- 3. The student will receive a PID stamp that will allow them to stay in the country for 90 days.

4. Before the expiration date, the stamp must be renewed online at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs web page.

**IMPORTANT:** If a visa is not required, but the student plans to stay more than 180 days in Colombia, it is mandatory to apply for a visa
